1. Background

The project aims to improve food security in Tharparkar, strengthen smallholder livestock farmers/ producers through value chain development, enterprise promotion, and collective marketing mechanisms. Under the project, Farmers Enterprise Groups (FEGs) and Farmers Market Collectives (FMCs) have been formed to support collective production, and marketing.

Sukaar Foundation therefore invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from qualified suppliers/companies for following:

2. Objective of the EOI

The purpose of this Expression of Interest (EOI) is to identify technically competent suppliers and companies with relevant experience in establishing of collective storage, processing and marketing operations in meat in tharparkar district. Through this EOI, Sukaar Foundation intends to gather technical information and potential solutions from the market for the establishment of enterprise facilities for the livestock value chains in District Tharparkar.

These facilities will support Farmers Market Collectives (FMCs) in improving product handling, storage, processing, and marketing.

2. Planned Facilities

Sukaar Foundation plans to establish the following enterprise facilities in District Tharparkar:

Facility type	Description
5 Livestock Collective Storage, Processing and Marketing Enterprises (Meat Value Chain)	The enterprises will support collective livestock-based businesses operated by FMCs along with VCA at accessible locations near

markets or transport routes. Each facility will include infrastructure for meat handling, cold storage, and hygienic processing, along with essential utilities such as water supply, waste management, weighing equipment, and basic office/storage space. Minor renovation or construction may be required, and retail or wholesale outlets may be included to improve market access

Interested suppliers/companies are expected to propose technically appropriate solutions, and list of equipment with specifications, and BOQ suitable for rural enterprise operations.

4. Scope of Work

The vendor/company will be responsible for:

- Site assessment and technical recommendations,
- Plan a visit for Sukaar foundation to their already existed processing unit and Sukaar team will receive presentation
- Facility (Livestock Collective Storage, Processing and Marketing Enterprises (Meat Value Chain)) design and layout planning
- Preparation of Bill of Quantities (BOQ)

The vendor/company must ensure that the proposed systems are efficient, durable, and appropriate for small-scale rural enterprises.

4.1 Meat companies Facility

Meat companies for the storage, processing, marketing and sale of meat products. The vendor/company is expected to propose a suitable technical solution that may include:

- Slaughter facilities
- storage and refrigeration facilities
- solar inverters and batteries
- Counters
- storage boxes
- renovation
- equipment
- (Slaughter Knives (Different Sizes) , Sharpening Stone / Knife Sharpener , Hooks and Chains ,Bleeding Tray / Collection Tray , Skinning Knives ,Heavy Duty Chopping Block , Butcher Knives , Meat Cleaver ,Bone Saw / Electric Bone Cutter , Stainless Steel Cutting Table , Meat Grinder / Mincer , Digital Weighing Scal)

The unit should improve processing efficiency, product quality, and market readiness of meat , produced by smallholder farmers.

5. Eligibility Criteria

Interested suppliers or companies must meet the following criteria:

- Legally registered with SECP/FBR with valid NTN
- Demonstrated experience in similar assignments
- Availability of technical staff for installation and maintenance

Experience working with development organizations or donor-funded projects will be an added advantage.

- Proof of company registration
- Similar Purchase Orders of the Previous Work (If any)
- Technical experience and capacity of the firm
